



NCBC Team Bowling Invitational

Date: 1/26/22

Time: 10:00 a.m.

Location: Cadillac XBC, 650 La Porte Rd, Waterloo, IA 50702

Teams: Charles City, Columbus Catholic, Decorah, Denver, Forest City, North Fayette Valley, North Iowa, Oelwein, Sumner-Fredericksburg, Tripoli, Waukon and Waverly-Shell Rock.

Tournament Details: Bakers rules from the season are to be used, but a team cannot consist of more than 6 players. Lanes will be drawn as teams arrive, and will not be drawn until one other team is present.

- **Round 1:** All teams (boys and girls) will be on accompanying lane pairs (i.e. Charles City girls on lane 10, boys on lane 11). All teams will bowl 10 baker games, bowling 2 games one lane, then switching and bowling 2 games on the other lane of the pair. Teams will not move pairs during the first round. Ties will be awarded according to the best score on the final game (As listed above).
 - Pods of four will be utilized for the first round, with a blank pair of lanes in between the next pod. (i.e. Lanes 1-4 in use, 5-6 off, 7-10 in use, etc.)
- **Round 2:** Based on scores from Round 1, teams will be seeded into an 8 team single elimination bracket, where teams will play a best of 3 head-to-head match to advance.
 - If a tie occurs in the first 2 games of a head-to-head match, a third will be bowled, with the best record of the three games advancing. If after 3 games both teams have the same record for the three games, total pins for the 3 games will determine the advancing team. If total pins is a tie, then the higher seed will advance.

Team Information: To help with traffic flow and reduce congestion, we will split team “home bases” between the two ends of the center. Six teams will be located in the bar area, and six teams will be located in the arcade area. Teams are asked to leave **ALL** bowling bags, coats, shoes and other items in these areas to help maximize space for teams, coaches and spectators.

The following teams will be located in the arcade area: Charles City, Columbus Catholic, Decorah, Forest City, North Fayette Valley and North Iowa.

The following teams will be located in the bar area: Oelwein, Sumner-Fredericksburg, Tripoli, Waukon and Waverly-Shell Rock

Spectators: Gate fees of \$5 per spectator will be collected at the entrance. Doors for the event at Cadillac will not open to spectators until 9:15 a.m. Please communicate this to your fans and coaches to help make this day run smoothly.

Team arrival: Teams please try to arrive to Cadillac no later than 9 a.m. so you can get settled into your camp. We will have the lane assignments available at the gate as spectators arrive.
